2002 Amberhill Merlot, California

90 POINTS **summary:** Nearly black in appearance, this medium-bodied effort exuded aromas of oak, cola, dried fruits, blueberries and spice. "*Clove fans would love this!*" one taster remarked, given this wine's uniquely spicy character. Jammy blackberries also made an appearance on the palate, as the fruit-driven finish "*keeps you coming back for another taste.*"
