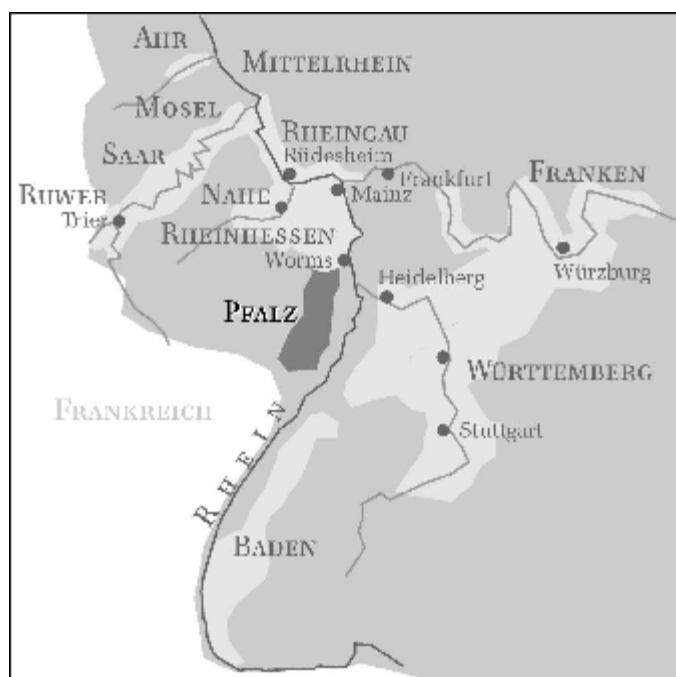


Weingut Bassermann-Jordan - Pfalz



- Wine:** 2003 Forster Jesuitengarten Riesling Spätlese BJ14-03
- Producer:** □ The Jordan Family started Wine Growing in the 18th century. Friedrich von Bassermann-Jordan was the author of the seminal work on The History of Winegrowing. Today the estate is managed by Margit von Bassermann-Jordan. Very special is the estate's museum of old wines, starting with an 1706 Forster Ungeheuer. Their winemaker Ullrich Mell is one of the most respected in Germany
- Region / Vineyards:** Jesuitengarten is an outstanding vineyard in Forst. The vineyard once belonged to the Jesuits from a cloister in nearby Neustadt. The sandy soils are variably mixed with loam, limestone, marl or sandstone pebbles.
- Vintage:** A winter with plenty of rain combined with the warm early spring days set off rapid and luxuriant vegetation. One of the hottest and driest summers since 100 years followed. Harvest was well ahead 2 – 3 weeks and rewarded vintners with an exceptionally good vintage.
- Taste Profile:** A well-structured Spätlese with powerful aromas of honey and tropical fruit, underscored by a lively acidity. It has a long finish and shows great aging potential.
- Pairings:** This wine can balance hot and spicy food, such as Thai or New Orleans cuisine. It is also a wonderful apéritif or a nice accompaniment to slight spicy cheese.
- Wine Profile:** Alc. by Vol.: 9.5 %, residual sugar: 6.34 % (63.4 g/l), acidity: 0.77 % (7.7 g/l)
grape variety: 100 % Riesling
