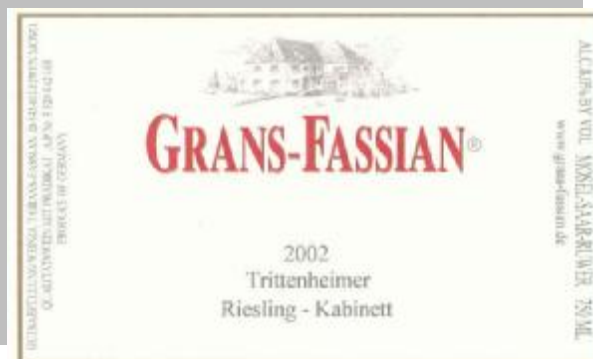


## Weingut Grans-Fassian – Mosel-Saar-Ruwer



- Wine:** 2003 Trittenheimer Riesling Kabinett GF2-03
- Producer:** The Grans-Fassian winery founded in 1624, is situated next to the bend in the river Mosel between Leiwen and Trittenheim, one of Germany's most beautiful landscapes. Here wines are produced with uncompromising measures, as only is done along the Mosel: an intensive fruit of fine elegance with not too much alcohol.
- Region / Vineyards:** This vineyard lies on a south – southwest facing slope with an inclination of 48 % The Devonian slate soil allows the water to pass to the deep rooting vines. The sun warms the soil during the day whereas the slate soil emits the warmth slowly to the vines during the night.
- Vintage:** A winter with plenty of rain combined with the warm early spring days set off rapid and luxuriant vegetation. One of the hottest and driest summers since 100 years followed. Harvest was well ahead 2 – 3 weeks and rewarded vintners with an exceptionally good vintage.
- Taste Profile:** This Kabinett wine has a very clear nose with aromas reminiscent of citrus fruit and mineral slate. A full-bodied wine, elegant and fruity with a balanced sweetness and good acidity which has an aging potential of 8 – 10 years.
- Wine Profile:** Alc. by Vol.: 8.0 %, residual sugar: 4.75 % (47.5g/l), acidity: 0.82 % 8.2 g/l  
Grape variety: 100 % Riesling
